The Fund seeks to achieve its investment objective by acquiring, holding and disposing of direct or indirect investments primarily in asset management firms across multiple strategies, geographies and asset classes ("GP Stake Investments"). The Fund will generally focus its investments in institutionalized alternative asset management firms. Under normal circumstances, the Fund will invest at least 80% of its net assets (plus any borrowings for investment purposes) directly or indirectly in GP Stake Investments. To maintain liquidity and to meet underlying capital calls, the Fund may also invest in certain liquid investments, including

ETFs, derivatives (including futures contracts and option contracts), equity and fixed income securities, exchange-traded GP Stake Investments, business development companies ("BDCs") and cash or cash equivalents. The Fund may borrow funds to make investments. As a result, the Fund would be exposed to the risk of borrowing (also known as leverage), which may be considered a speculative investment technique.
