The Fund's investments (the "Fund Investments") are expected to include (i) direct investments in the equity, debt and/or related investments of operating companies (ii) primary and secondary investments in pooled investment vehicles ("Portfolio Funds") managed by third-party managers ("Portfolio Fund Managers"); and (iii) liquid investments, including, but not limited to, listed private equity investments, business development companies, broadly syndicated loans ("BSLs"), collateralized loan obligations ("CLOs") and other listed investments.
